

SUMMER CAMP WEEK 2010 JOB DESCRIPTIONS

CABIN COUNSELOR: A Cabin Counselor (CC) will live with and direct a cabin of up to 16 campers. CCs are responsible for the safety and well being of their campers. They will maintain a healthy cabin and participate with their campers in activities, worship, programs, and all camp activities. The CC is also responsible for mentoring the Junior Counselor. All summer staff will be given additional duties as needed.

ACTIVITY LEADER: The Activity Leader (AL) will lead a specific activity, possibly two, for the summer. They must be proficient in the activity and able to maintain safety and teach effectively. The AL is responsible for the up-keep of that activity as well as keeping the equipment stocked and in good repair. Activity Leaders will be encouraged to be creative in presenting their activity to give campers the best experience possible. Certification in a particular activity is preferred. Activity Leaders will also be part of the Design Team that will create, set up and lead various all-camp activities and the Olympic events. All summer staff will be given additional duties as needed.

LIFEGUARDS: Lifeguards must have certification. Responsibilities include constant supervision of campers at the pool, maintaining a clean pool area, and enforcing all pool rules. Lifeguards work with a Head Lifeguard in creating and maintaining the safety rules, and creating waterfront all camp programs. Each Lifeguard will also be an activity leader and part of the Design Team. All summer staff will be given additional duties as needed.

JUNIOR COUNSELOR: A Junior Counselor (JC) will live in a camper cabin and act as an assistant to the Cabin Counselor (CC). JCs are to learn from the CC and begin to develop their own skills in preparation of being a Cabin Counselor. Duties will include daily supervision of campers, participation in cabin devotions, cabin and camp activities and programs. Junior Counselors will be assigned a variety of daily camp clean up duties as well as participate in helping the Design Team with various programs. All summer staff will be given additional duties as needed. Junior Counselors are selected based on previous camping experience, maturity and responsible behavior, qualifications and training, availability and a formal interview. Junior Counselors will be evaluated weekly on their performances.
